CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION TO AEAJ EVENTS

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

AEAJ events are free of charge.

Two sources of funding are possible: national funding and AEAJ funding:

- Participants have to prioritise national funding when possible. National funding refers to all
 possible sources of funding for participation to an AEAJ event provided by a court, judicial
 school, superior council, etc. at the national level. If you have any doubt, please check with your
 AEAJ national contact point if you are eligible to a source of national funding, and under which
 conditions.
- AEAJ funding is subsidiary, in case no national funding is available. It is provided through a lump sum from the AEAJ budget for each working group. Co-chairs are responsible of the use of this sum.

How to apply for AEAI funding:

Already in their application, participants have should indicate if they claim for AEAJ funding. After the event, they have to claim for the reimbursement of their costs to our treasurer Ralf Höhne before the deadline indicated for each working group, provide the supporting documents, including bills for accommodation and travel means as well as tickets or boarding passes, and indicate the IBAN and BIC code of their bank account. Covered costs include travel and accommodation for two nights.

The lump sum is equally divided between the participants who claimed for funding, in the limit of their coverable costs and up to the maximum amount of 400 euros per person. For this reason, the exact amount of the AEAJ funding can only be estimated after the event.

WG Taxation: 30 June 2025.

WG Environmental Law: 31 October 2025.

WG Asylum and Immigration: 31 October 2025.

Please note than no AEAJ funding will be provided for participation to the General Assembly.

3.- CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION TO JOINT EJTN-AEAJ SEMINARS

To participate to a joint EJTN-AEAJ seminar, please address your candidacy to the contacts above, and inform simultaneously your AEAJ national contact point.

If the number of candidates exceeds the AEAJ contingent, a selection based on geographical diversity will be made and the AEAJ team may ask the national contacts point to select between applicants from their country.

If the AEAJ contingent is full, it is still possible to follow the ordinary process to participate to EJTN training, in order to be nominated on the EJTN contingent. This is determined at the national level and we advise you to contact the <u>EJTN</u> contact point in your country.

The travel costs of all participants (whether or not proposed by AEAJ) are covered by the EJTN according to its <u>Corporate financial policy</u> (i.e. 500 euros maximum with exceptions for travel costs, and a per diem depending of the country of the event for food and accommodation).
